Dear Shareholders:

In response to the new regulations issued by the Ministry of Culture of the People's Republic of China regarding the control of virtual currency in online games, we would like to take this opportunity to announce that we are cancelling the "Treasure Box" feature in *ZT Online* effective July 6, 2009. We believe such change will have a very limited impact on our revenue.

On Friday June 26, 2009, we decided to discontinue the "Treasure Box" feature and we issued a notification on the gamer website of *ZT Online* to inform our gamers of this change. Meanwhile, we will continue to develop new functions and gameplay to keep our gamers engaged.

The "Treasure Box" feature is a mini-game where users may discover desirable items inside a treasure box if they are lucky. The "Treasure Box" exists in most Chinese online games and we are the first company to announce a cancelation of this feature as a responsive action to the new regulation from the Ministry of Culture.
